New Nonpartisan Coalition Launches Presidential Climate Action Plan
Comprehensive Global Warming Blueprint for New President's First 100 Days

Denver, Colorado—On Tuesday, December 4th, 2007, a team of climate experts based at the University of Colorado and advised by a distinguished national committee will release its detailed action plan for the next President to jump-start federal leadership on global warming. This comprehensive policy blueprint is called the Presidential Climate Action Plan.

Known as PCAP, the plan is the most comprehensive – and in many respects, the boldest – plan for climate action yet put before the American people and the presidential candidates. Designed for rapid implementation by America's 44th President during his or her first 100 days in office, PCAP will be presented to every presidential candidate, challenging each one to adopt its recommendations and publicly pledge to take bold action on climate change.
